About Dr. Henry

Dr. Henry earned her DVM at Auburn University in 1990, her MS from Auburn in 1993 and gained board certification in oncology in 1994. Dr. Henry served on the Washington State University faculty before relocating to the University of Missouri in 1997. She has served on the American College of Veterinary Internal Medicine (ACVIM) Board of Regents and is past president of both the Veterinary Cancer Society and the ACVIM Specialty of Oncology.

In April 2010, Henry was named Faculty Facilitator for the Mizzou Advantage One Health/One Medicine initiative by the Office of the Provost—a position that serves to foster multidisciplinary educational and research opportunities between human and veterinary medicine and the basic sciences, both within the University of Missouri and with outside collaborators.

Most recently Dr. Henry formed WAMCOH, a collaborative partnership with her veterinarian-scientist colleagues at WUSM and Auburn. The consortium's mission is based on the emerging concept of "One Health," focusing on the health linkages among humans, animals, and their shared environments.
